

Calls for Elections

Several AWMA Officer positions are open for the term 2025-2029, and we can only be successful with a complete working team. We are accepting nominations for AWMA officer positions until September 16, 2025. To be filled are the following positions:

President

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics. Must be a (Full or Associate) Professor working in an African University.

Duties

- Spokesperson for AWMA
- Presides meetings and prepare agenda
- Ensures that AWMA activities are aiming at achieving AWMA's objectives.
- Appoints chairpersons to all committees
- Is a financial signing officer

Vice-President (West Africa)

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics and reside in West Africa

Duties

- Serve as a regional coordinator;
- Gather and pass on information to the President;
- Perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Vice-President (East Africa)

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics and reside in East Africa

Duties

- Serve as a regional coordinator;
- Gather and pass on information to the President;
- Perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Vice-President (Central Africa)

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics and reside in the Central African region

Duties

- Serve as a regional coordinator;
- Gather and pass on information to the President;
- Perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Vice-President (Southern Africa)

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics and reside in the Southern African region Duties

- Serve as a regional coordinator;
- Gather and pass on information to the President;
- Perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Vice-President (North Africa)

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics and reside in North Africa

Duties

- Serve as aregional coordinator;
- Gather and pass on information to the President;
- perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Secretary

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics. Duties

- Take minutes at all General Assembly meetings;
- Present an annual report on the activities of AWMA;
- respond to all correspondence on behalf of the Association;
- Is a financial signing officer;
- Perform other duties as may be assigned to her by the President or General Assembly.

Vice Secretary

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics. Duties

- Act in the absence of the Secretary;
- be the secretary to the Workshop/Conference committee;
- Keep an up-to-date register of members of AWMA
- Perform any other duties that may be assigned by the President, the Secretary or the General Assembly.

Treasurer

Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics. Duties

- Be the Trustee of the accounts of AWMA;
- Present an annual audited financial statement to the General Assembly and members of AWMA;
- Be a signatory to the accounts of AWMA;
- Perform such duties as may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.

Publicity and Information Officer Eligibility: must be an African Woman with a Ph.D. degree in Mathematics. Duties

- Be responsible for the visibility of the Association and all its activities;
- Be actively involved in the sourcing of funds for AWMA:
- Perform such duties as may be assigned by the President or General Assembly.
